## March 17, 2018

- Rentals
  - Based on the information she heard at the Fishers HOA meeting this week, Dina is suggesting that we move toward no further rentals in our neighborhood
  - Three of the neighborhoods are going to no rentals in their subdivision; three other neighborhoods are considering it
  - How would we manage knowing when a rental company was trying to purchase?
  - First step: talk to lawyer about how to implement no rentals in neighborhood; then hold a special meeting with proxy; will announce steps via website and paper
    - Does anyone need Community Service Hours (JHS, Boy Scouts/Girl Scouts, etc.) to help us distribute letters (240 houses)
    - Goal date to get these out: April 17
    - Action Item: meet with lawyer re: options
    - Special meeting is Sunday, May 6<sup>th</sup> at 4:30; rain date is Wednesday, May 9<sup>th</sup> at 7pm at pool parking lot
    - Pool keys distributed at the special meeting; must have ID to sign for your key

## • Pool

- o Hours
  - Working on pool hours within budget
  - Action Item: Loree needs to pay pool company half of invoice so they can open 2-3 weeks ahead of time
  - Weather plan: Supervisor or Parker makes the call to send home for inclement weather
  - Action Item: Dina will send Loree list of lifeguard duties/procedures
  - Action Item: Dina and Loree will reach out to Rocky Wilson/Eric
    Freuchtel to help set up pool key tech prior to special meeting

## • Pond

- o City of Fishers will take of culverts, including replacing, riprap, etc.
- Going to put this project back out to proposal to see if we can get better quotes/ideas/etc.; will keep Thomas Dock on the back burner
- o Ecosystem on our water is great do not need to dredge!
- We DO need to take care of the muskrats, though
- o The pond has eroded at least 5 feet in the last 20 years
- Crime Watch
  - Action Item: Sierra send CW sign up sheet and CW brochure to Taulbees; reminder that all residents should be BCC:ed on emails so residents can't see each other's' emails

- See if the Taulbees are willing to walk for CW between April 17-25 so they can distribute newsletters/proxys and collect CW signatures at same time
- Other business
  - Look for a lockbox/drop box to install at the pool house for a secure exchange
  - Action Item: Signs advertising website have arrived; Sierra needs to put those out at front entrance median and Perlita entrance next to No Soliciting sign
  - o Action Item: Loree will draft mailbox/yard improvement checklist
  - Action Item: Sierra get started on newsletter template and begin adding info; the rest of the board will send in necessary info
- Finance
  - We need to add both Dina Slain and Heather Rollag to all Sweet Briar POA bank accounts with Old National Bank
  - Explore the idea of putting together a two-year project plan; get estimates on pool, consider breaking out pond into multiple years if necessary, include other large projects to minimize surprises for residents
