## HOT TOPICS

**School bus safety.** It's not hard to figure out why this topic is first on the list. Police reports have been filed numerous times for reports of cars passing buses with extended stop signs while children were boarding, speeding around buses, and running stop signs at our intersections. PLEASE think of the things that could go wrong in these situations and that could have a lasting impact. Our stop signs are not suggestions, and the children boarding those buses are your neighbors. Take your time, slow down, and obey the law. And remember, the Fishers PD traffic division patrols in unmarked cars.

If you'd like to report a vehicle for unsafe driving (or to report any other suspicious or criminal activity in our neighborhood), use the Fishers Crime Watch app (it's free). "Erratic Driving" is one of the choices.

**Parking.** If you must park on the street, please watch where you're parking and be sure to leave room for other cars to pass through. Remember that it is illegal to park directly across from a driveway! Please also remember that parking overnight in the pool parking lot is prohibited.

**Park Etiquette.** If you own a dog and you take it on a walk, it will probably use the bathroom. With that in mind, please never leave home without a baggie to pick up after your furry friend. Our sidewalks and park paths are used by hundreds of neighbors, and whether they love dogs or don't, it's a guarantee that they don't want to step in your dog's leftovers. **#justbeagoodneighbor**
